Eating

- Must have **Dutch treats**...croquettes, frites, pannekoeken and stroopwaffle ©
- Our favorite spots...
 - o **Febo** frittes & croquettes, Dutch version of McDonald's but SO much better
 - o **Saturnino** (Reguliersdwarsstraat 3-5) great Italian
 - **Krua Thai** (Staalstraat 22) best Thai in town, probably some of best Thai ever! And get the Pepper leaf appetizer!
 - o **Stroopwaffle** from Albert Cuyp Market
 - o **Vlaamse Friteshuis** (Voetboogstraat 33): best frites (French fries!) place is just off touristic shopping street Kalverstraat and get the frietjes sauce!
 - o **Pancakes! Amsterdam** (Berenstraat 38) great pannekoeken spot in the Negen Stratjes (9 Little Streets shopping area). There are <u>several locations now</u>.

Places to See

- Neighborhoods:
 - We lived in the De Pijp neighborhood & Utrechtestraat (with cheese shop, bakery, Coffee Salon, cute shops)
 - o Jordaan including Nine Little Streets (Negen Straatjes) cute shopping street in the Jordaan with lots of great shops
 - o Dam & Central Station
 - Museumplein
